#### Australian Stock Horse Futurity, Maturity & Challenge rules and regulations of entry

- All horses (except Youth riders under 12 years) must be registered with the ASHS and owned by current financial members. All riders must be current ASH financial members. Proof of membership and horse registration to be provided with nominations (photocopy of registration papers and membership).
- 2. The horses age is at 1 August 2015.
- The Gympie ASH Branch and the Australian Stock Horse Society shall not be responsible for any damage or injury occasioned to any exhibit or property of any exhibitor(s) from any cause whatsoever
- 4. The Gympie ASH Branch reserves the right (on veterinary advice) to refuse any animal, if judged unfit or diseased, to take part in any way, and for the animal to be removed from the grounds. Veterinary's decision is final.
- The organising committee and ground jury reserve the right to alter the programme, judges or schedule.
- Random swabbing may take place at this show. The Gympie ASH Branch reserves the right to test any animal for drug or stimulant, but will not be held responsible for any injury or death caused by such a test
- 7. The judges decision is final subject to all other conditions being met.
- 8. STALLIONS and COLTS must be handled or ridden at all times by a person over 18 years.
- This show will be conducted in accordance with the rules, regulations and bi-laws of the Australian Stock Horse Society. Competitors are advised it is their responsibility to read and abide by the ASH Rules.
- 10. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.
- 11. All rings start at 7.30 each day and all rings will run concurrently.
- 12. The show society reserves the right to combine, alter or delete classes with insufficient entries.
- 13. Lead riders must stay led for all events throughout the weekend in all rings.
- 14. All horses competing in hack rings must be officially measured unless they are in possession of a current EA or SHC height certificate.
- 15. All horse and rider gear including saddlery and riding apparel must be in good working order. Random checks for safety of gear may take place. Any competitor with gear deemed to be unsafe will not be allowed to compete.
- 16. Please shop with our sponsors and thank them for investing their time and money into our event. Without them we would not have been able to bring you all the prizes and prize money.
- 17. Each section to be scored out of 100 points.
- 18. All horses will be scored for each section, unless disqualified.
- 19. The score for hi-point is the aggregate for all sections.
- 20. Tie for hi-point will be either a ride off or a count back at the organizing committee's discretion, with a count back to be based on ridden sections.
- 21. In the event of 2 or more placing equal, prize money will be averaged and ribbons balloted.
- 22. Judges must be on ASHS accredited list or ACA list for cattle work.
- Committee's discretion for judges. If 1 judge is used per section, it must be a different judge for each section.
- 24. It is recommended that a judge does not judge the same section at another futurity/maturity/challenge in the series during the same year.
- 25. Each branch should notify the other committees of their judges if possible.
- 26. Horses must compete in all phases to be eligible for hi-point awards.
- 27. Led section organizing committees discretion of how judging will be conducted.
- 28. Cattle work for 3yo futurity & 4yo maturity conducted in the campdraft arena. One beast in the yard at a time. Competitors able to go left or right outside. No 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> pegs, but 1 peg for gate. Scoring will be out of 25 points for each section. Camp (losing beast back twice incurs nil points, outside run still allowed). 1<sup>st</sup> circle, 2<sup>nd</sup> circle and peg. (40 sec outside time allowed).
- 29. **Open challenge** cattle/campdraft section is conducted as per ASHS events handbook. A win will not change the competition status of a horse.
- 30. Encouragement Challenge Open to ASH members 18 years and over who have not ever won or placed overall in any futurity, maturity, hack or open challenge or have not won 2 or more encouragement challenges and have not won a high point encouragement challenge at any time (weanlings, yearlings futurities places not included). Riders may ride any age registered ASH horse and may compete in any other event. Please note only amateur riders are eligible to compete. If



you are an encouragement rider at the first futurity you remain an encouragement rider for all of the futurities for that year. Competitors restricted to one horse and may ride any age registered ASH and may compete in any other events. This event will be with 3 rings in action, with competitors going from one to the other in their draw.

- 31. **Junior and Senior Hack Challenge** attire is optional, either ASH or English attire but horses must be ridden in a snaffle bit.
- 32. **Junior Hack challenge** led score will be taken from 2,3 or 4yo futurity/maturity classes.
- 33. Senior Hack challenge led will be held at the conclusion of futurity led classes.
- 34. Senior and Junior Hack Challenge Please advise if you are 18-21 when entering
- 35. Riders can be changed provided the event has not commenced and that the rider has a good reason (eg: sickness/injury) and this substitution can only happen once per horse per event.
- 36. Riders can only be changed after commencement of an event for the following reasons such as injury, sickness or family bereavement at the discretion of the organizing committee
- 37. Horses can be substituted provided the event has not commenced and the substitute horse can be verified as ASH registered and the horse meets all the requirements of that event.
- 38. After nominations close, fees will only be refunded in exceptional circumstances, (such as the event of lameness) an administration fee of \$10 plus any relevant cattle levy may be retained.
- 39. Organising committees that deem a horse unfit for competition prior to the commencement of an event on the day may give a refund, less administration fee of \$10 plus cattle levy where applicable.
- 40. Each branch in the series is to provide the SQMC point's coordinator within 14 days of completion of event their overall results from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> placing.
- 41. The SQ Hi-Point will be 1<sup>st</sup> 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 9 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 8 points etc with any ties will be allocated equal points ie 1<sup>st</sup> 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 9 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 8 points etc.
- 42. It is suggested these recommendations be displayed at each venue.
